**MEMBERS OF FEDERALY FUNDED, NEWLY FORMED, COMPUTER LAB
TO OFFICIALLY COMMIT RESOURCES, SIGN FORMAL AGREEMENT;
EQUIPMENT ON DISPLAY**

WHAT: Orange County law enforcement officials will be available tomorrow to discuss the Regional Computer Forensics Lab (RCFL) and the challenges they face concerning the increasing level of cyber crime in southern California. Chiefs from the following law enforcement agencies participating in the new RCFL will host a press event tomorrow to officially sign a Memorandum of Understanding to formalize their commitment to combatting cyber crime by devoting personnel and other resources.

RCFL examiners, currently located in a temporary facility while the new site is being finalized, will exhibit and explain some of the tools used to conduct forensic examinations of all forms of digital media in support of investigations, as well as to display examples of unusual or "exotic" media.
